
- With all the runners needing to pick up their packs our Expo and Rego will be open from 10am 6:00pm in Port Douglas.

#### DAY BAG DROP (21.1KM, 10KM & 5KM ONLY)

To ensure you can enjoy a few hours in Port Douglas at the end of your run we are offering a Bag Drop Transfer service. If you want a spare change of clothes, shoes, toiletries etc. when you arrive at the finish line on Four Mile Beach Port Douglas after your run, please utilise this bag drop service. Only small bags will be accepted in our bag drop service, (our transport vehicle has limited space and cannot transport other luggage).

Within your registration pack you will find a bag tag runner number at the base of the BIB. Simply tear off and attach this label to the outside of your bag so it is clearly visible. This number **must** match your BIB number!

Do not leave any personal valuables within the bag. We accept no responsibility for any lost, damaged or stolen items.

#### WHERE AND WHEN?

- **No bags** will be accepted at registration on Saturday, 13 September 2025 (Crystalbrook Superyacht Marina).
- Please drop your bag to the team at the Bag Drop truck which will be parked near the start arch on Wharf Street.
- The truck will depart after the 5km run starts at 7:30am
- Your bags will be transported to the Recovery Lawn and will be available for collection from the bag drop truck parked on the Esplanade.





#### **RUN DAY SERVICES**

#### FIRST AID / AMBULANCE


If you need medical assistance, please phone the number on back of your BIB to arrange help or wave down the nearest Event Official for assistance. Quote your BIB number.

- There will be an ambulance and roaming first aid responders on the course.
- Runners are responsible for any costs incurred as a result of a medical incident, this includes but is not limited to ambulance transfers, hospital stays, specialist treatment, medical appointments etc. It is strongly advised that all runners have adequate personal insurance.
- All runners are responsible for understanding the terms and conditions for this event and the terms and conditions of insurances held.

#### **SAG WAGON**

If you need SAG Wagon assistance please phone the number on the back of your race BIB to arrange help or wave down the nearest Event Official for assistance. Quote your BIB number.

- SAG Wagon will collect runners who are unable to complete the event or are unable to finish within the course cut-off time. Collected athletes will be transported back to the finish area at Four Mile Beach.
- Delays in SAG Wagon transport are expected. To assist with a prompt pickup, please do not move from your reported location once a SAG Wagon has been requested as this can affect their ability to locate you.





# 21.1KM KOM À QOM

The 21.1km Half Marathon includes the climb up to the Flagstaff Hill Lookout, which is one of the most photographed locations in the region.


So why not make it interesting and see who can be the fastest to run up the hill?

There will be a sign on the road where the official climb starts and another sign where the timing will finish. The distance is 810mtrs.

Otherwise, we hope you enjoy the challenge of running/walking up to this amazing lookout!








#### **AID STATIONS**

There are multiple Aid Stations spread across the course. Each station is equipped with water, Winners electrolyte, Premax sunscreen, public and/or portable toilets. Winners Gels will also be available for the Pacific Toyota 10km and 21.1km Half Marathon runners.

Location and distances of each Aid Station vary by event. Please see the following course maps for your race to see where they are located for your race.





#### FINISH AND CUT OFF TIMES

To meet the road re-opening times which are a condition of our road closure permits, we have set cut-off times for some events.

21.1km Half Marathon	Pacific Toyota 10km

 If you are still on the course when the roads need to re-open the crew will ask you to continue your run/walk along the footpaths.

#### FINISH LINE & RECOVERY LAWN AREA






